




# Row, Row, Row Your Boat


Give a two measure intro of C & C6 (4 beats), all downstrokes (d d d d).





Row, row, row your boat, Gent - ly down the stream,





Merri-ly, merri-ly, mer-ri-ly, mer-ri-ly, Life is but a dream.  
If \_\_\_ you see \_\_\_ a cro - co - dile, \_\_\_ Don't for-get to scream.

After you've sung and strummed this, be sure to pluck out the melody; it's a great one for practicing a good portion of your C scale.

The C scale is played with this fretting pattern ('0' stands for the open string):

- 0 2 on the 3rd String
- 0 1 3 on the 2nd String
- 0 2 3 on the 1st String

Assign one finger per fret (try not to just slide one finger around).

Now play it backward:

- 3 2 0
- 3 1 0
- 2 0

Now apply your scalar knowledge to the song above.

Once you've mastered plucking it, play it in a round with some friends.
